Sub: Regular Promotion in the cadre of ACIT for the vacancies of the R.Y. 2014-15 - matter regarding.

Kindly refer to the above.

Kindly refer to the ongoing impasse regarding the regularization of the ACsIT, who have been promoted on ad-hoc basis, against the vacancy year 2014-15 vide the order dated 07.04.2016. Though the DoPT OM dated 04.03.2014 ensures their correct inter se seniority vis-a-vis their Direct Recruit counterparts for now, it will be of no help for them in further promotions unless they are regularized by 31.03.2017.

As per the IRS Recruitment Rules, 2015, one of the criteria for DCIT promotion is 4 years regular service in the grade of ACIT. At the same time, if any junior is being considered for promotion, then his senior will have to be considered, if the latter has completed regular service of at least the half of the residency period as on the cut-off date i.e. at least two years in this case as on 01.04.2019. For 2014 Batch promotee officers, who are in 1:1 position (i.e. has at least one DR below in the seniority list of 2014-15), one will be considered for DCIT promotion if he completes at least 2 years regular service as on 01.04.2019. So, the **PR officers of 2014-15 are to be promoted on regular basis by 31.03.2017 mandatorily** to make them eligible for the DCIT promotion as on 01.04.2019 along with the DR officers of same batch, and for all further promotions in due time.

Under the circumstances, your goodself is requested to pursue and convince all the authorities concerned about the **dire need of regularization of the ACsIT of the R.Y. 2014-15 by 31.03.2017**, so that the career progression of this batch of officers will not be aborted irreversibly.

This is for your kind consideration and necessary action.
