Subject: Amendment of existing Transfer/Placement Guidelines of IRS officers - regarding.

The above referred matter was discussed in the Quarterly Review meeting of the respected Chairman, CBDT with the representatives of JCA on 14-10-2014. The representatives of ITGOA raised the issue of "Amendment of the existing Transfer & Placement Guidelines'. The Chairman, CBDT, also expressed the need for amendments in the existing guidelines and requested us to submit the proposed amendments of the existing 'Transfer/Placement Guidelines for officers of the Indian Revenue Service, CBDT' to the Board for consideration.

2. We propose the amendments required in the Transfer/Placement Guidelines issued vide notification no. HRD/PM/444/2/2008-09/1515 of CBDT dated 16-02-2010 as below:
